- Self-determination is a fundamental right of democracy, essential to the pursuit of political, social and economic equality.
- By their military service, Puerto Ricans deserve to have their voices heard.
 (200,000 in uniform, 6,220 wounded and 1,225 killed to defend our Constitution)

We commend the supporters of this process. We urge the Senate leadership to fulfill its responsibility to promote the rights of all citizens by enacting Puerto Rican self-determination legislation during National Hispanic Heritage Month.
